LINKS TO LITERACY

1. Learn to spell the words accurately by completing the word search. Circle or put a line through each word as you find it.
2. If you do not know what a word means, please look it up to improve your musical vocabulary.
3. Consider how many syllables each word contains. A syllable is part of a word that contains a single vowel sound.

The word 'tun-er' has the vowel "u" in the first half of the word and the vowel "e" in the second half of the word. The 5 vowels are A, E, I, O, U.

When two (or more) vowels are next to each other, the number of syllables depends on the number of vowel sounds, i.e. free = 1 syllable, eat = 1 syllable, but bio = 2 syllables.

Musical examples:-

- a) Nut, Pegs & Strap are all single syllable words (1 syllable only)
- b) Head-stock & Fret-board all have 2 syllables (2 parts, or 2 vowel sounds making up one word).
- c) So-prano has 3 syllables.
- d) U-ku-le-le has 4 syllables.
- e) So-pra-ni-ssim-o has 5 syllables

4. Consider how many syllables (or vowel sounds) each word contains in this word search, and list them in the right columns below.
