## SONATA IN C# MINOR Opus 27 No 2/ "MOONLIGHT" SONATA by BEETHOVEN

- ☐ Beethoven wrote 32 piano sonatas
- ☐ A piano sonata is a solo piece for piano
- ☐ The word sonata comes from the Latin word sonare which means 'to sound'.
- ☐ A sonata is a piece of music sounded by instrument(s) as opposed to a cantata from the Latin word cantare which is a piece of music that is sung.
- ☐ Traditionally the 1<sup>st</sup> movement would be in **sonata form** and overall the sonata would be made up of 3 or 4 movements or sections.
- ☐ Beethoven completed the sonata in 1801 and it was published under the name "Sonata quasi una Fantasia"
- ☐ It was nicknamed the "Moonlight" sonata after Beethoven's death by a German music critic called Ludwig Rellstab, as the music reminded him of the moon setting over Lake Lucerne.
